It was an exciting year for the library from thoughtful and compelling updates to our collection, to memorable in-person events, to innovative programming, and more.


Pickup Lockers and Expansion




In January, the library added hold lockers for convenient 24/7 material pickup, and then expanded the number of lockers in August. The green lockers are located outside the lower-level entrance to the Main Library parking garage. To use the service, patrons may choose the lockers as a pickup location when placing items on hold using the MPPL app or website.

Strategic Plan

We conducted a strategic planning process from January – June and went live with a new plan in July. The ultimate goal of the process was to hear directly from the community about how the library can best serve them.

Library Card Renewals? They're Automatic!

In March we transitioned from manual library card renewals to an automated address verification system. This means that residents don't have to come into the library to renew their cards anymore! We've dubbed this service "auto-renewal for patrons."

In-house Laptop Lending

As of April, we now offer PC and Mac laptops to use in the library. These laptops include a variety of software including MS Office and Zoom. PC laptops are available at both Main and South Branch, and Mac laptops are available at the Research desk at the Main library.

Our latest collection of non-traditional items was a hot commodity in 2022. In March we debuted fun and useful items such as hotpots and Chromebooks, and games like Kan Jam and a karaoke machine. Stop by

Lucky Day Collection

We debuted our "Lucky Day" collection in July, featuring copies of the most popular, hard to get books and movies. This means that if you have been waiting for your hold for a while, you could check the Lucky Day shelves in

the Main Library lobby to see if it's your lucky day! If what you want is on the shelf, you can check it out for two weeks with no wait.



Mac Studio

In 2022 we were awarded a grant through the Illinois State Library to purchase two Mac Studio computers for public use. These computers are equipped with the Adobe Creative suite, the iLife Suite, VHS to digital conversion hardware/software, Super 8/8mm. film to digital conversion hardware/software, a DVD/Blu-Ray burner, and a flatbed scanner to convert photos, negatives, and slides to digital images.

Mount Prospect Library cardholders can reserve the Mac Studio computers in advance for up to 3 hours; visitors with cards from area libraries can use the computers on a walk-in basis if they are available. Staff have created simple instructions for many of the computer's functions. For more in-depth learning, the library has a variety of books, e-books, digital videos, and digital courses available.




