MOUNT PROSPECT PUBLIC LIBRARY DENIAL OF SERVICE POLICY

- 1. Mount Prospect Public Library affirms Article 5 of the American Library Association's Library Bill of Rights:
 - "A person's right to use a library should not be denied or abridged because of origin, age, background, or views."
- 2. Use of Mount Prospect Public Library facilities or services will not be abridged or denied solely on the basis of the medium of patron contact, whether in-person, by telephone, or by other electronic means.
- 3. Use of Mount Prospect Public Library facilities and services may be limited when the presence of such patron and/or his/her excessive demands for staff time, available materials, or space, impair or risk impairing, the provision of library services to other individuals or groups.
- 4. Patrons of the Library may be suspended from the Library building and grounds by Library staff when they engage in behavior which disrupts normal library operations.
- 5. Use of Mount Prospect Public Library facilities and services may be denied for due cause. Such cause includes, but is not limited to, any of the following:
 - Assault of a staff member or member of the public;
 - Behavior of any kind dangerous to individuals, staff, or other patrons;
 - Deliberate damage of Library materials, property, or facilities;
 - Disruptive behavior when using computer equipment;
 - Eating in an area not designated for food consumption at the Main Library or South Branch;
 - Excessive and continued noise;
 - Failure to resolve overdue fines and/or fees:
 - Failure to return library materials;
 - Fighting;
 - Harassment of staff or other patrons;
 - Interference with Library patrons, the public, or staff resulting from poor hygiene or body odor;
 - Intoxication;
 - Littering;
 - Loitering:
 - Possession of a weapon, including a concealed firearm, alcohol or illegal drugs;
 - Running, shoving, or similar misbehavior on library property;
 - Shaving, laundering, bathing in restrooms;
 - Sleeping;
 - Taking photographs or videos of an individual library patron or staff member without his/her permission;

- Taking photographs or videos of an individual minor patron without his/her parent/legal guardian's permission;
- Theft;
- Using unauthorized wheeled utilities in Library or grounds;
- Use of tobacco products i.e., all forms of tobacco products, including but not limited to cigarettes cigars, pipes, water pipes (hookah), electronic cigarettes, smokeless tobacco, snuff, and chewing tobacco.
- 6. All Mount Prospect Public Library staff are responsible for enforcing Library policies regarding the general safety of employees and patrons, protection of Library property, and proper deportment on Library grounds.
