


How to Place an Interlibrary Loan Request



1. Sign in to your MPPL account on our Web Resources page.





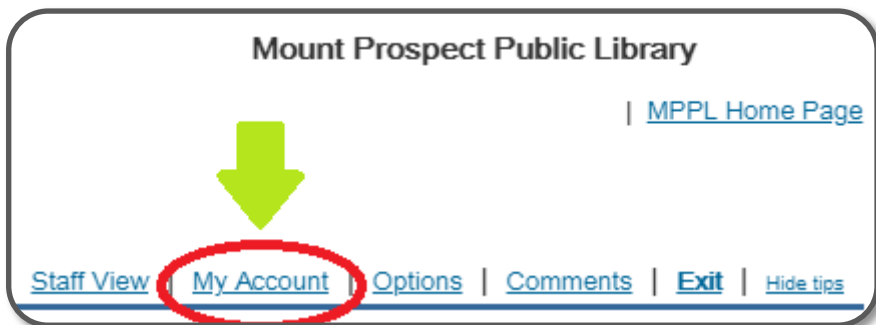

Creating an OCLC Account

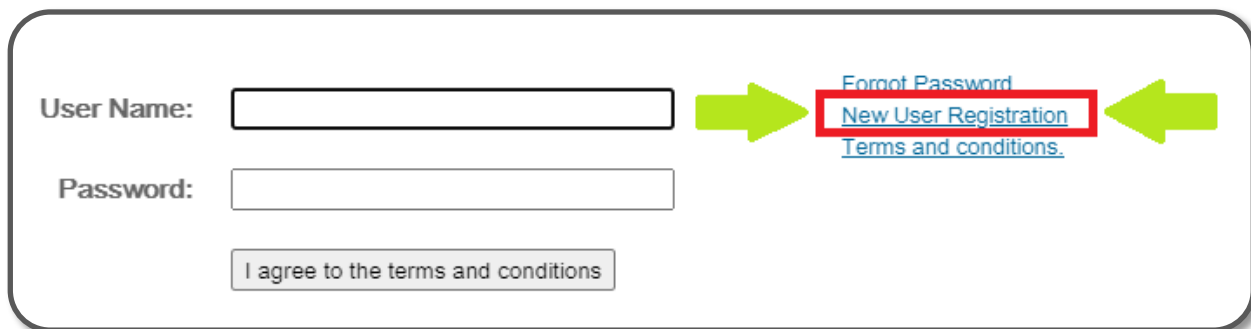
