**Individual teacher library cards** will be created this year replacing traditional school-wide issued cards. Your individual teacher card will allow you to access the following services:

**Teacher Book Bags:** As in previous years, teacher bags contain 20-25 items on one or more requested topics. Items may be limited based on seasonally high-demand topics. Materials are intended to be used in the classroom. School district drivers may pick up requested teacher bags or teachers may also pick up their own bags at the library.

**Leisure Reading Bags\*:** Leisure reading bags include reading material for free-reading classroom time. Teachers can request fiction, nonfiction, graphic novels, or a mixture.
