### INVESTIGATOR'S REPORT



Subject "M. Dewey" was observed staggering to the second floor center display and collapsing at the Mount Prospect Public Library at approximately 12:25PM on Tuesday, September 24th, 2024. EMTs arrived at 12:37PM and found the subject unresponsive. The subject was transported to Enduro Health Commuters Hospital where he remains in a coma. Medical staff concluded that the subject's condition was the result of an undetermined poison. The Mount Prospect Police Department is treating the incident as an attempted homicide.

Interviews have established that the subject had an extremely consistent routine at noon every workday: watering the giant plant near the Mystery collection; going in front

of the Teen Space to scavenge for loose change; purchasing Flaming Hot Cheetos in the vending area and eating them with a yogurt acquired from the break room refrigerator while drinking his coffee; visiting the New Mystery section and ensuring that the same particular title was on prominent display, generally leafing through it first to check for signs of use; and stopping by the 3-D printer to "customize" whatever job was printing.

In light of this information, investigators have concluded that there are five possible <u>locations</u> where the poisoning could have happened:

- 1. Giant plant
- 2. Teen Space
- 3. Vending area
- 4. New Mystery books
- 5. 3-D printer

And they have also determined five possible methods of poisoning:

- 4. Paige Shelfinheimer
- 5. Ashley Cardin-Booker

Medical and police resources have moved on to more urgent matters, leaving this case unsolved. It is hoped that an independent investigation might be able to uncover the solution.

- 1. What's behind the glass dedicated to several Zielinskis? Don't look for a book, but search near the bookshelf with the Detective Varg titles.
- 2. You may get blue if you want to watch *Spirted Away* in a higher-resolution format than DVD, but don't worry we have a place you can go for that.
- 3. Where a bishop and a knight/Can simulate a fight/On a square of black and white/With Harold's sign in sight
- 4. The P.I. Spenser's author also wrote tales of the old American frontier. Look for where his rhapsody is shelved.

So different from my fave podcast, Murder at the Museum - the head curator is killed by one of his staff but they're all so obvious and dumb about their motives. Pretty sure nobody here would snuff Dewey. Me? Okay, he stole my yogurt out of the break room fridge every day. EVERY. DAY. Who even does that?!? But no normal person would ever get homicidal over something like that. Hey, I'll let you know when I solve this for you."
