# MacStudio Quick Start Steps for The Zoom Digital Audio Recorder







• Record Push once for setting levels, again to start recording.



- Headphones
- Headphone volume control
- Power button slide on/slide off

• Stop, Play/Pause, Fast Forward, and Rewind buttons.



- Menu Scroll Wheel Push to Select Option
- Menu On/Off
- Record Level plus/minus
- SD Card Slot





- To power on, slide the power switch towards you and let it go.
- The switch will spring back to the original position and the unit will turn on.
- You'll repeat this step to turn the unit off when you are done with it.




#### The Zoom Recorder LCD Screen shows you:

- Elapsed time of recording
- Battery charge remaining
- Left and Right Channel record levels
- Available space on the SD card



### **Zoom Recorder Menus**

- Push the Menu button on the right side.
- Scroll using the Menu Wheel also on the right side.
- Push the Menu Wheel to make a selection.
- Each folder contains additional options.



# **Example Menu**

- In this example we can select which folder to store the audio file you'll create.
- Use the Menu Wheel again to make a selection.
- Push the Menu Button to exit the menus.





## Record, Input Selection, and Level Settings

- •Select inputs 1 and 2
- •Touch the Record button once. It will start blinking.
- Play the source (tape/record).


- Set the record level using the +/- on the *right* side. Do not use the control on the *left* side. It is headphone volume only.
- The segmented bars appearing in L&R should bounce near the right side during the loudest part of the playback.
- Touch the Record button again to start recording. It should be lit constantly as it records.




• When you are ready to retrieve your files open the SD compartment door and remove the SD card.



• Once you've removed the SD card from the Zoom unit, insert it into the card reader in order to copy your audio files.





# Folder Layout on the SD Card

- Select the H4N\_SD card.
- Having recorded using the Stereo setting, select the Stereo folder.

# Layout in the Stereo Folder

- Select the folder holding your record and copy it your computer.
- Once copying is complete, delete the files from the card, eject the card and return it to the Zoom recorder.
