SPRING BOOK SALE

With nearly record warm weather recently it looks like spring has arrived several weeks early this year, but the Friends big **Spring Book Sale** will be held on the usual dates, **April 20**th, **21**st **& 22**nd. Continuing with tradition, this will be a **three room sale** but breaking with tradition we are making a small change.

The individually priced **better books** will be in the large Meeting Room A, where we will offer a large assortment of newer and better books. This will include many really nice children's better books, audio books on CD, music CDs, records and full length movies on DVD.

The **25¢ Sale** will be in the small Meeting Room B and will feature older paperbacks, video tapes, cassettes and books on tape.

Regularly priced books will be down stairs in the Friends Sale Room. There you will find a carefully sorted selection of tens of thousands of hard bound and paperback books priced at \$1.00 or 50¢. As before there are lots of nice kid's books and a selection of teacher materials. We also continue to have a good selection of Large Print books.

There will be bargains and treasurers to be found in all three rooms. Stop by and see what your can find.

BOOK SALE

We've only had two serious snow storms so far this year and both fell on our book sale dates. It snowed so hard on Friday January 20th that only about two dozen people showed up for members' night. Typically about five times that many members attend Friday night. We recovered a bit on Saturday but at \$7,560 the sale was down somewhat overall. Kudos to the hardy souls who trekked in from out of state.

It snowed again on February 11th during the cook book sale. But that was a Super Saturday which drew in quite a crowd of parents and kids. We sold over \$800 of newer and better cook books in couple of hours.

Donations to the Friends are reviewed by the Library's Collection Development staff for items to go into the permanent collection. The Friends sorters have a list of books the staff is looking for and the staff looks through the sorted items on a regular basis. In the first quarter of 2012 the staff added over \$4,500 (list price) worth of books to the collection from donations to the Friends. That saves tax money that can be spent on other things. Special thanks to those people who have made all these generous donations to the Friends for the benefit of the Library.

SOUTH BRANCH BOOK SALE

The Friends have scheduled a book sale for Saturday May 12th at the Community Connections Center (South Branch) at 1711 W. Algonquin Rd just west of Busse. We plan on featuring kids books in both English and Spanish as well as an assortment of novels for the adult patrons. This will be our first book sale at this location.

EVENING BOOK DISCUSSION

On Saturday, March 10, the Friends Evening Book Discussion was featured in the *Chicago Tribune* and recognized for the over 22 years the group has been meeting. Continuing in April, they will read Pat Conroy's <u>South of Broad</u>, a study in friendship. The May book is Brunonia Barry's <u>The Lace Reader</u>, a rather different mystery set in modern day Salem Massachusetts. <u>The Art of Racing in the Rain</u>, by Garth Stein will give us a dog's-eye-view of life on the professional race car circuit. Indeed three very different books for your reading pleasure. The Group meets on the third Wednesday of every month at 7:30 pm in Meeting Room B and new Friends are always welcome. However, the number of copies of the book available may be limited. We ask that you let us know ahead of time if you are planning to join us.


