HELP WANTED NEEDED

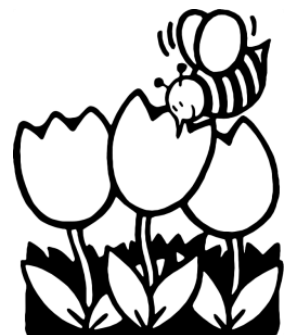

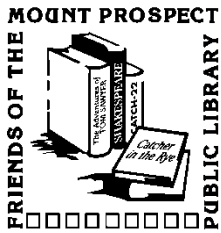
